

## **INTRODUCTION to 'PRACSOFT' SOFTWARE for GENERAL PRACTITIONER SURGERIES**

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course covers the basic functions of the extensively used computer software known as 'Pracsoft' designed for General Practitioner practices. The course will develop the knowledge required to operate the functions such as patient data entry, scheduling and patient appointments, patient billing and receipting in general medicine. Course covers the 'shortcut' functions for basic operations in the system.
